U.S. Dept. of Veterans Affairs General Counsel Paul Hutter to Discuss Voter Registration Directive with Secretaries of State

Washington, DC—The National Association of Secretaries of State today announced that Paul Hutter, general counsel for the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, will address its membership on Saturday, July 26 from 8:00 AM to 9:00 AM at the Amway Grand Plaza as part of the NASS 2008 Summer Conference in Grand Rapids, Michigan. Hutter will discuss the subject of voter registration services at VA facilities.

"We are grateful to Secretary James Peake and his senior staff for reaching out to assist secretaries of state in understanding the VA's May 2008 directive on voter registration activities," said NASS President Todd Rokita, Indiana Secretary of State. "Their willingness to directly address our members on this topic will help to ensure that state and local election officials can clarify their own policies and act properly to provide our nation's veterans with access to voter registration information and materials according to the law."

The National Association of Secretaries of State, the nation's oldest, nonpartisan professional association for public officials, will be holding its annual summer meeting in Michigan from July 25-28, 2008. Thirty-nine of its members serve as chief state election officials.
