



### **NASS Resolution in Opposition to S. 2083 “The Interstate Recognition of Notarization Act”**

WHEREAS, the Executive Board of the National Association of Secretaries of State (NASS) adopted an Interim Position in opposition to [S. 2083](#) the Interstate Recognition of Notarization Act on May 8, 2008 by a vote of 10-0 via email; and

WHEREAS, according to the NASS Bylaws, an Interim Position is only valid until the next regularly scheduled membership meeting which was set for Monday, July 28, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the NASS Executive Board based their Interim Position on the recommendation of the NASS Business Services Committee who received and reviewed analysis of S.2083 by both the Notary Public Administrators Section (NPA) of NASS, who were opposed to the legislation and the National Notary Association (NNA), who endorsed the legislation and a letter voicing concern over the legislation from the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Law (NCCUSL); and

WHEREAS, the NASS Business Services Committee did not recommend any changes to be made to the Interim Position during their committee meeting on July 26, 2008;

THEREFORE, NOW BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Interim Position has expired and the membership of the National Association of Secretaries of State has voted to oppose S.2083 “The Interstate Recognition of Notarization Act”
