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Colorado ID Theft Milestones

- Aug 2006 Identity Theft and Financial Fraud Deterrence Act.
 - Creates Colorado Fraud Investigators Unit within the Department of Public Safety
 - Establishes surcharge of \$3 per uniform commercial code filing with Secretary of State
- July 2010 Launched <u>www.ProtectYourBusiness.us</u>
 - Partnered with Colorado Attorney General and Colorado Bureau of Investigation(CBI)
 - Provides resources and tips for preventing and detecting business identity theft
 - Provides information for victims of business identity theft.
- March 2011 Email notification implemented.
 - Sends notice when a form has been filed affecting your record

Milestones Continued...

- January 2012 Secure Business Filing implemented.
 - Requires a password and email in order for a document to be filed
 - PIN number is mailed to principal office address to establish security
- July 2014 Increased UCC contribution in support of CBI ID theft unit.
 - Increased surcharge from \$3 to \$4 through July 2018
 - Approximately \$400,000 annually
 - Funds approximately 3.5 FTE to include crime analyst and special agents
- May 2016 Legislation extending CBI Fraud Investigator Unit through 2025.

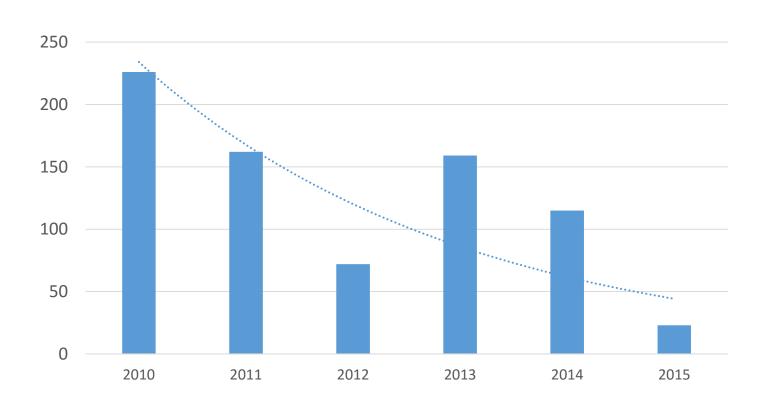

Information Provided by SOS to CBI

- Assist ID Theft Unit with information requests
- Provide name and credit card information
- Run data inquires of registry
 - Example: All delinquent or dissolved businesses that have been cured or reinstated after five years.
- Provide certified copies of filed documents
- CBI agents participate in lean training with SOS staff
