#### Background

 Registered entities file Annual Reports at different times throughout the year.

Business Corporations	Jan. 1 – March 31
Non-Profit Corporations	June 1 – June 30
LLCs	Sept. 1 – Nov. 30

- Filing periods were developed to allow for expeditious processing of paper Annual Reports.
- With the increase in electronic filing, the need to allow for different filing periods is no longer relevant.

#### **The Solution**

Beginning in 2022, all registered entities file Annual Reports between February 1 and May 1 each year.

- All administrative filings are due at the same time each year.
- Professionals who manage the filings for multiple entities need only track one filing period.
- Filing period extended by 30 days for Business Corporations and LLCs; 60 days for Non-Profit Corporations.



# BIG Your Annual Report NEWS filing period is changing

Beginning January 1, 2022, all entities (LLCs, Business Corporations, and Non-Profits)

will file their annual reports with the Business Services Division

between February 1 – May 1 each year.
