

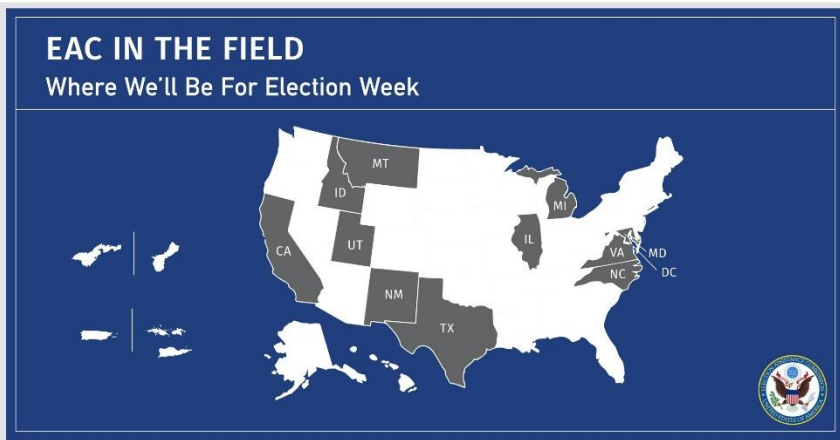

2018 Midterm Elections



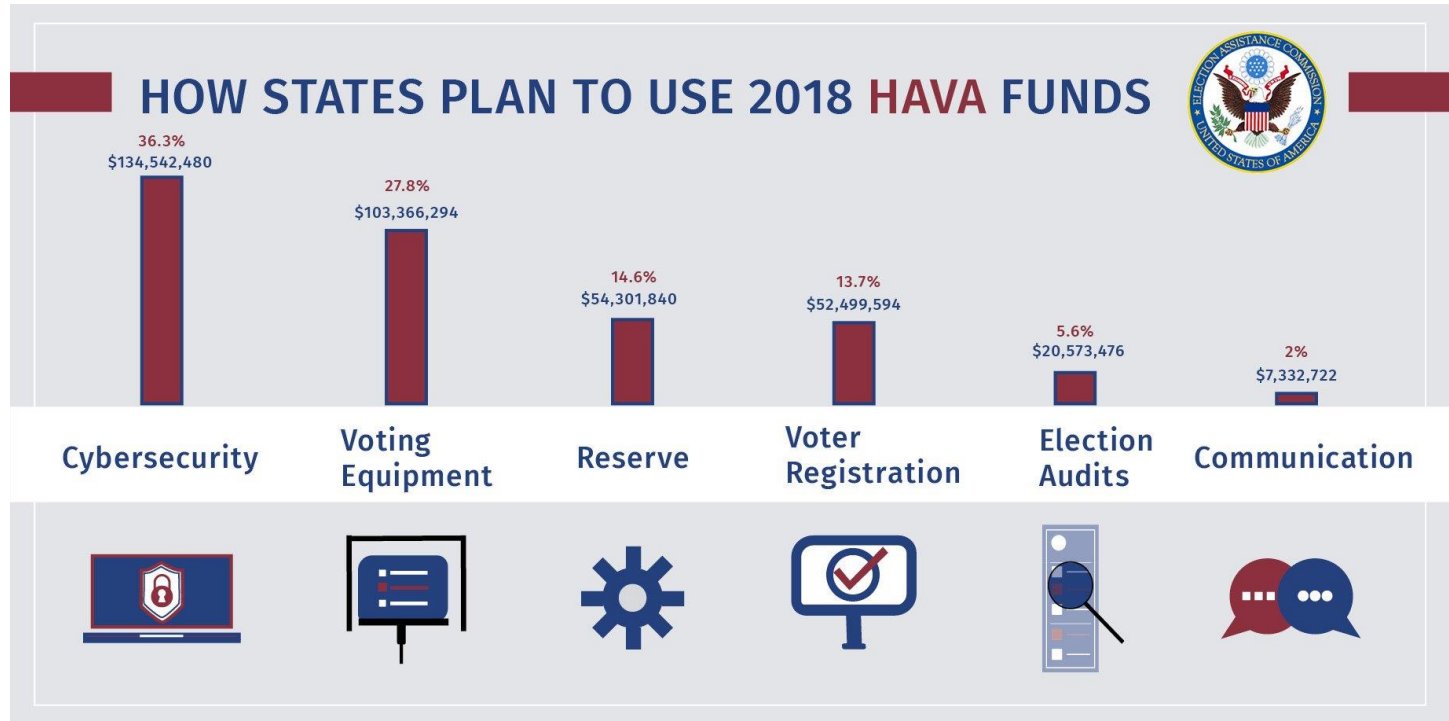
Successes

- \$380 million in 2018 HAVA funds distributed to states and territories by Sept. 20
- Better security and communication between election officials and federal partners
- Record turnout
- There were no issues in the vast majority of jurisdictions

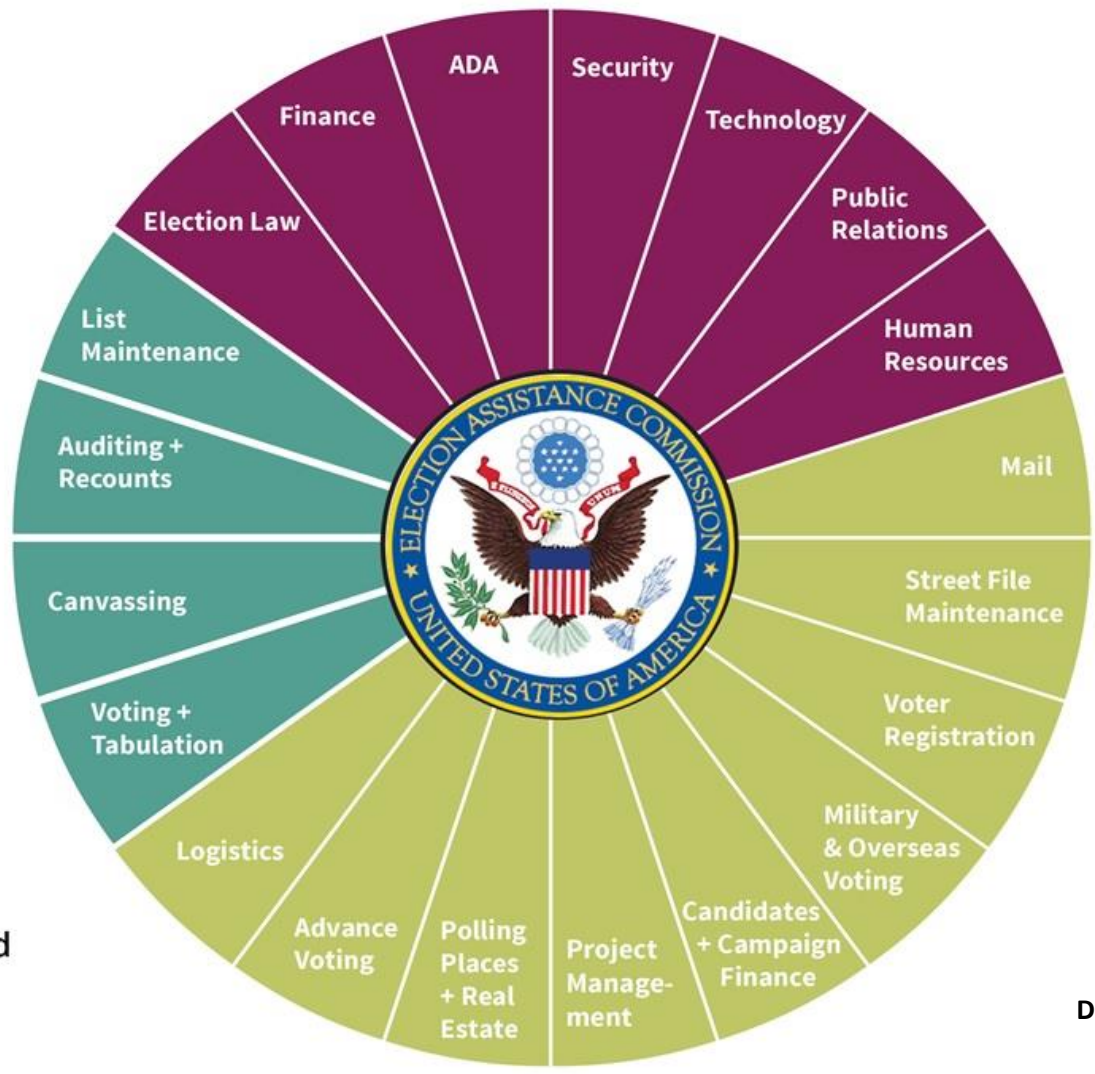
Challenges

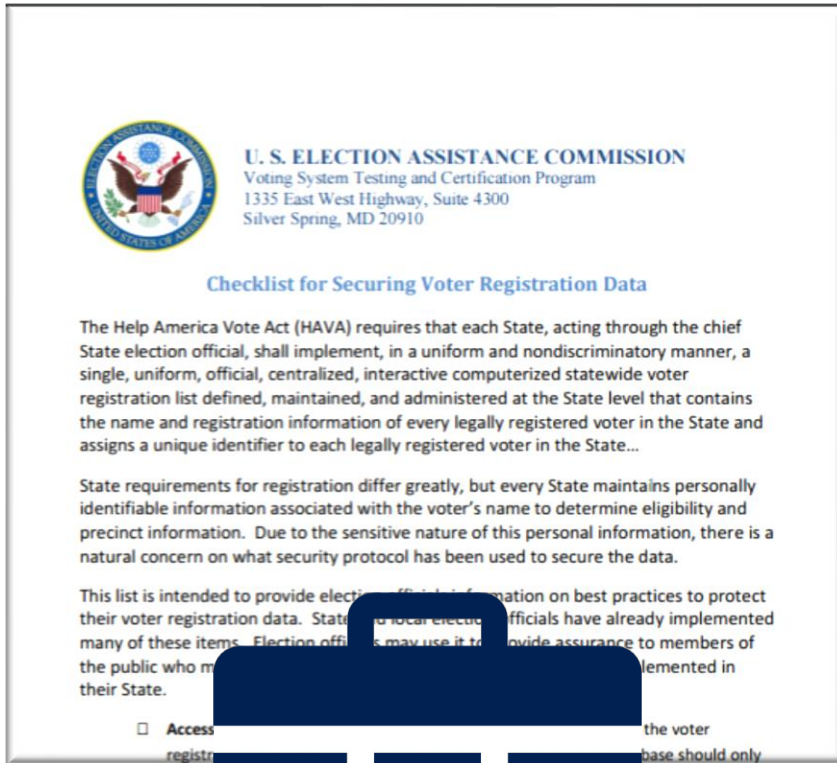

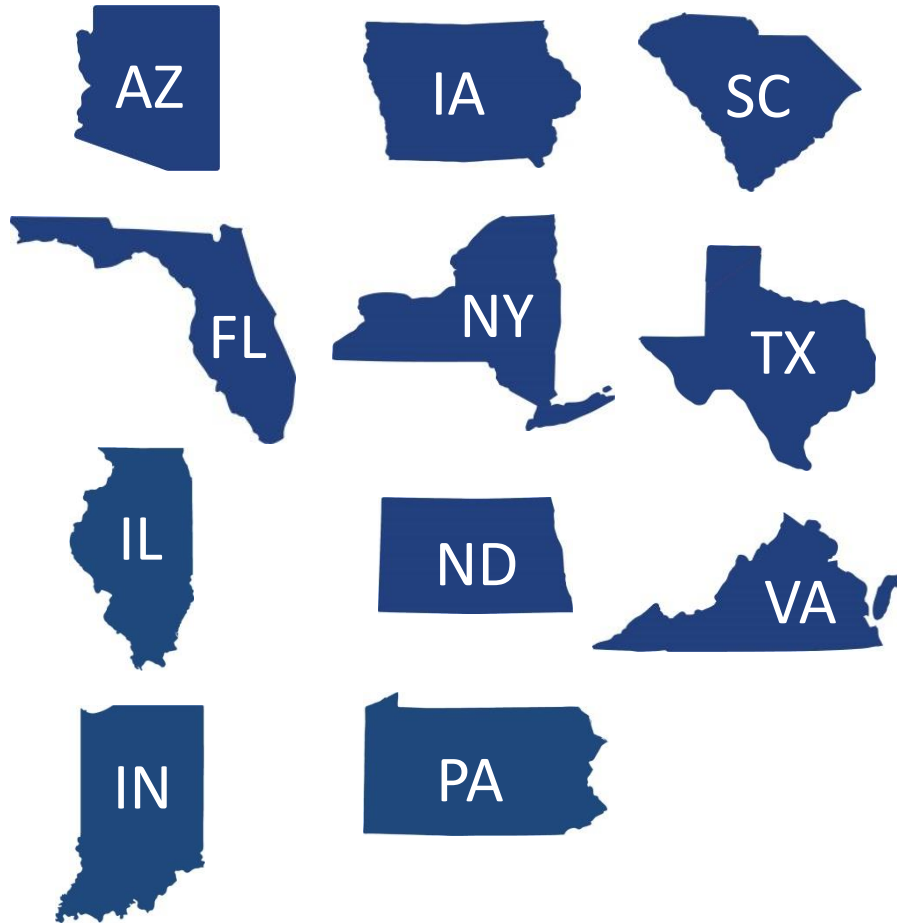
Election Administrator as IT Manager
